14	Section 1. Section 23-5-312, MCA, is amended to read:
15	"23-5-312. Prizes not to exceed \$800 \$1,999. (1) A prize for an individual live card game may not
16	exceed the value of \$800 \$1,999. Games may not be combined in any manner so as to increase the value of
17	the ultimate prize awarded. Except during a tournament conducted under 23-5-317, all prizes must be awarded
18	immediately upon completion of each hand.
19	(2) If a licensed operator conducts a promotional game of chance involving a live card game, the
20	prize limit provided for in subsection (1) applies to prizes awarded as a result of the promotional game of
21	chance."
22	
23	Section 2. Section 23-5-607, MCA, is amended to read:
24	"23-5-607. Expected payback verification. (1) The department shall prescribe the expected
25	payback value of credit awarded to be at least 80% of the value of credit played for each bingo, poker, keno,
26	and video line game in a video gambling machine. The credit ratio may not be greater than:
27	(a) 92% for each video line game;
28	(b) 96.5% for each bingo and keno game; and

3	may use to verify the winning percentage."

5	Section 3. Section 23-5-608, MCA, is amended to read:
6	"23-5-608. Limitation on amount of money played and value of prizes payment of credits in
7	cash ticket voucher expiration rules. (1) A video gambling machine may not allow more than \$2 \sum 3 to be
8	played on a game or award free games or credits in excess of \$800 \$1,199 a game.
9	(2) A licensee shall pay in cash all credits owed to a player as shown on a valid ticket voucher.
10	(3) The department may establish by rule a reasonable time period during which a player shall
11	present a valid ticket voucher to the licensee for payment before the voucher may be considered expired and
12	invalid."
13	
14	NEW SECTION. Section 4. Effective dates. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), [this act] is
15	effective January 1, 2024.
16	(2) [Section 2] and this section are effective on passage and approval.
17	
18	NEW SECTION. Section 5. Applicability Grandfather. [Section 1] applies to video gambling
19	machine games placed into operation on or after January 1, 2024.
