11	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Certification reciprocity for military members, military spouses, and			
12	veterans requirements. (1) The superintendent of public instruction shall issue a teacher certificate AND			
13	ENDORSEMENT or specialist certificate as provided by Title 20 to a person:			
14	(a) who is certified <u>AND ENDORSED</u> in good standing in another state or a United States territory as			
15	a teacher or specialist; <u>AND</u>			
16	(b) (1) who is a member of the armed forces of the United States or whose spouse is a member of			
17	the armed forces of the United States;			
18	(c)(II) who is subject to military orders for a change of station to a duty station in this state, who is in			
19	the process of a change of station to a duty station in this state, who has been honorably discharged and is			
20	relocated to this state, or whose spouse is the subject of a military transfer to this state; or			
21	(d)(III) who is the spouse of a military member, and the spouse left employment to accompany the			
22	military member to this state- <u>; OR</u>			
23	(IV) WHO IS THE DEPENDENT OF AN ACTIVE-DUTY MEMBER OF THE UNITED STATE ARMED FORCES WHO HAS			
24	BEEN TRANSFERRED TO MONTANA, IS SCHEDULED TO BE TRANSFERRED TO MONTANA, IS DOMICILED IN MONTANA, OR			
25	HAS MOVED TO MONTANA ON A PERMANENT CHANGE-OF-STATION BASIS.			
26	(2) In issuing a certificate <u>AND ENDORSEMENT</u> under subsection (1), the superintendent of public			
27	instruction may:

2	determines the	e requirements for certification AND ENDORSEMENT in the other state are substantially equivalent to				
3	the requiremer	the requirements in this state; or				
4	(b)	if the requirements for certification AND ENDORSEMENT are not substantially equivalent, issue the				
5	person a temporary teacher certificate AND ENDORSEMENT or specialist certificate to authorize the person as a					
6	teacher or specialist while completing any specific requirements by the office of public instruction.					
7	(3)	The provisions of subsection (1) do not apply to a person whose teacher certificate or specialist
