	18	(1) "WARNING: Consumption of marijuana may cause anxiety, agitation, paranoia, psychosis, and
	19	cannabinoid hyperemesis."
2	20	(2) "WARNING: Consumption of marijuana by pregnant women may result in fetal injury, and low
2	21	birth weight, congenital anomalies, and inherited cancers developed by a child later in life."
2	22	(3) "WARNING: Consumption of marijuana by nursing mothers may result in infant hyperactivity
2	23	and poor cognitive function.""
