12	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Ultraviolet light treatment of community and public water supply
13	systems reimbursement for expenses. A lf a community water system, as defined in 75-6-102(4), or a
14	public water supply system, as defined in 75-6-102(15), that has between 15 and 50 service connections, was
15	installed on or before July 1, 2025, and the water is disinfected with only the use of ultraviolet light, the
16	department shall annually reimburse the system owner for certified operator sampling expenses is not required
17	to have a certified system operator if disinfection of the water is accomplished with the use of ultraviolet light.

19	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
20	integral part of Title 75, chapter 6, part 1, and the provisions of Title 75, chapter 6, part 1, apply to [section 1].
