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5 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER BILL OF
 6 RIGHTS; LIMITING WHAT INFORMATION ABOUT A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER MAY BE PROVIDED
 7 TO THE NEWS MEDIA OR REQUIRED BY AN OFFICER'S EMPLOYER."
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9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
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11 NEW SECTION. Section 1. Definitions. As used in [sections 1 through 3], the following definitions
 12 apply:

- 13 (1) "Law enforcement agency" has the meaning provided in 7-32-201.
- 14 (2) "Law enforcement officer" has the meaning provided in 7-32-201.
- 15 (3) "Person" has the meaning provided in 1-1-201.
- 16 (4) "State agency" means a department, board, commission, office, bureau, institution, or unit of
 17 state government recognized in the state budget.

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 19 NEW SECTION. Section 2. Limitation on release of law enforcement officer photos or personal
 20 information -- exceptions. (1) A person, state agency, or law enforcement agency may not release to the
 21 news media a law enforcement officer's home address, personal phone number, or any other personal
 22 information that may otherwise be considered confidential without the written consent of the law enforcement
 23 officer.

24 (2) (a) Except as provided in subsection (2)(b), a person, state agency, or law enforcement agency
 25 may not publicly release a photograph of a law enforcement officer.

26 (b) (i) A state agency or law enforcement agency may display a photograph of a law enforcement
 27 officer to a prospective witness as part of an agency or unit investigation or if the law enforcement officer has
 28 been arrested.

1 (ii) A state agency or law enforcement agency may release a photograph of a law enforcement
2 officer if the law enforcement officer provides written permission.

3 (iii) A state agency or law enforcement agency may provide a law enforcement officer the
4 opportunity to sign a one-time waiver to opt in to allowing the use of the law enforcement officer's photo.

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6 **NEW SECTION. Section 3. Limitation on certain law enforcement officer financial disclosures --**

7 **exceptions.** (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), a state agency or law enforcement agency may not
8 request of or require of a law enforcement officer for a job assignment or other personnel action any information
9 on the law enforcement officer's property, income, assets, source of income, debts, or personal or domestic
10 expenditures, including those of any member of the law enforcement officer's family or household.

11 (2) A state agency or law enforcement agency may request or require the information listed in
12 subsection (1) if the information:

13 (a) is obtained or required under state law or proper legal procedure, including but not limited to 2-
14 2-106;

15 (b) tends to indicate a conflict of interest with respect to the performance of the law enforcement
16 officer's duties; ~~or~~

17 (c) is necessary for the law enforcement officer's employing agency to ascertain the desirability of
18 assigning the law enforcement officer to a specialized unit ~~in which there is a strong possibility that bribes or~~
19 ~~other improper inducements may be offered, task force, or other coordinated law enforcement agency effort;~~

20 (d) is required as part of a background check during the hiring process; or

21 (e) is necessary as part of a background check to obtain a top-secret clearance.

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23 **NEW SECTION. Section 4. Codification instruction.** [Sections 1 through 3] are intended to be
24 codified as an integral part of Title 44, and the provisions of Title 44 apply to [sections 1 through 3].

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
