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HOUSE BILL NO. 824

INTRODUCED BY B. BARKER, N. DURAM, G. PARRY, P. GREEN

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REVISING REGISTRATION FEES FOR CERTAIN HIGH-VALUE VEHICLES AND WATERCRAFT; PROVIDING THAT THE FEE IS A PERCENTAGE OF THE MANUFACTURER'S SUGGESTED RETAIL PRICE; PROVIDING FOR ANNUAL INCREASES IN THE VALUES THAT ARE SUBJECT TO THE FEE; REVISING A DEFINITION; AMENDING SECTION 61-3-321, MCA; AND PROVIDING A DELAYED EFFECTIVE DATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

**Section 1.** Section 61-3-321, MCA, is amended to read:

**"61-3-321. Registration fees of vehicles and vessels -- certain vehicles exempt from registration fees -- disposition of fees -- definition.** (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section, registration fees must be paid upon registration or, if applicable, renewal of registration of motor vehicles, snowmobiles, watercraft, trailers, semitrailers, and pole trailers as provided in subsections (2) through (20).

(2) (a) Except as provided in subsection (2)(b), unless a light vehicle is permanently registered under 61-3-562, the annual registration fee for light vehicles, trucks, and buses that weigh 1 ton or less and for logging trucks that weigh 1 ton or less is as follows:

- (i) if the vehicle is 4 or less years old, \$217;
- (ii) if the vehicle is 5 through 10 years old, \$87; and
- (iii) if the vehicle is 11 or more years old, \$28.

(b) For a light vehicle with a manufacturer's suggested retail price of more than \$150,000 that is 10 years old or less, the annual registration fee is the amount provided for in subsection (2)(a) plus ~~\$825~~ 1% of the manufacturer's suggested retail price.

(3) (a) Except as provided in subsections (3)(b) and (15), the one-time registration fee based on the declared weight of a trailer, semitrailer, or pole trailer is as follows:

- (i) if the declared weight is less than 6,000 pounds, \$61.25; or

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- 1 (ii) if the declared weight is 6,000 pounds or more, \$148.25.
- 2 (b) For a trailer, semitrailer, or pole trailer that is registered under 61-3-701, the annual registration
- 3 fee based on the declared weight is as follows:
- 4 (i) if the declared weight is less than 6,000 pounds, \$30; or
- 5 (ii) if the declared weight is 6,000 pounds or more, \$60.
- 6 (4) Except as provided in subsection (15), the one-time registration fee for motor vehicles owned
- 7 and operated solely as collector's items pursuant to 61-3-411, based on the weight of the vehicle, is as follows:
- 8 (a) 2,850 pounds and over, \$10; and
- 9 (b) under 2,850 pounds, \$5.
- 10 (5) (a) Except as provided in subsections (5)(b) and (15), the one-time registration fee for off-
- 11 highway vehicles other than a quadricycle or motorcycle is \$61.25.
- 12 (b) Whenever a valid summer motorized recreation trail pass issued pursuant to 23-2-111 is
- 13 affixed to an off-highway vehicle other than a quadricycle or motorcycle, the one-time registration fee is \$41.25.
- 14 (6) The annual registration fee for heavy trucks, buses, and logging trucks in excess of 1 ton is
- 15 \$22.75.
- 16 (7) (a) Except as provided in subsection (7)(c), the annual registration fee for a motor home, based
- 17 on the age of the motor home, is as follows:
- 18 (i) less than 2 years old, \$282.50;
- 19 (ii) 2 years old and less than 5 years old, \$224.25;
- 20 (iii) 5 years old and less than 8 years old, \$132.50; and
- 21 (iv) 8 years old and older, \$97.50.
- 22 (b) The owner of a motor home that is 11 years old or older and that is subject to the registration
- 23 fee under this section may permanently register the motor home upon payment of:
- 24 (i) a one-time registration fee of \$237.50;
- 25 (ii) unless a new set of license plates is being issued, an insurance verification fee of \$5, which
- 26 must be deposited in the account established under 61-6-158;
- 27 (iii) if applicable, five times the renewal fees for personalized license plates under 61-3-406; and
- 28 (iv) if applicable, the donation fee for a generic specialty license plate under 61-3-480 or a

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1 collegiate license plate under 61-3-465.

2 (c) For a motor home with a manufacturer's suggested retail price of more than \$300,000 that is 10  
3 years old or less, the annual registration fee is the amount provided in subsection (7)(a) plus ~~\$800~~ 1% of the  
4 manufacturer's suggested retail price.

5 (8) (a) (i) Except as provided in subsections (8)(b), (8)(c), and (15), the one-time registration fee for  
6 motorcycles and quadricycles registered for use on the public highways is \$53.25, the one-time registration fee  
7 for motorcycles and quadricycles registered for off-highway use is \$53.25, and the one-time registration fee for  
8 motorcycles and quadricycles registered for both off-road use and for use on the public highways is \$114.50.

9 (ii) An additional fee of \$16 must be collected for the registration of each motorcycle or quadricycle  
10 as a safety fee, which must be deposited in the state motorcycle safety account provided for in 20-25-1002.

11 (b) (i) The annual registration fee for motorcycles and quadricycles registered for use on the public  
12 highways under 61-3-701 is \$44.

13 (ii) The annual registration fee for motorcycles and quadricycles registered for off-highway use  
14 under 61-3-701 is \$44.

15 (iii) The annual registration fee for motorcycles and quadricycles registered for both off-road use  
16 and for use on the public highways under 61-3-701 is \$88.

17 (iv) An additional safety fee of \$7 must be collected annually for each motorcycle or quadricycle  
18 registered under 61-3-701. The safety fee must be deposited in the state motorcycle safety account provided  
19 for in 20-25-1002.

20 (c) Whenever a valid summer motorized recreation trail pass issued pursuant to 23-2-111 is  
21 affixed to a motorcycle or quadricycle, the one-time registration fee for motorcycles and quadricycles registered  
22 for:

23 (i) use on the public highways is \$33.25; and

24 (ii) both off-road use and for use on the public highways is \$94.50.

25 (9) Except as provided in subsection (15), the one-time registration fee for travel trailers, based on  
26 the length of the travel trailer, is as follows:

27 (a) under 16 feet in length, \$72; and

28 (b) 16 feet in length or longer, \$152.

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1           (10) ~~(a)~~ –Except as provided in ~~subsection~~subsections (10)(b) and (15), the one-time registration  
2 fee for a motorboat, sailboat, personal watercraft, or motorized pontoon required to be numbered under 23-2-  
3 512 is as follows:

4           ~~(a)(i)~~ for a personal watercraft or a motorboat, sailboat, or motorized pontoon less than 16 feet in  
5 length, \$65.50;

6           ~~(b)(ii)~~ for a motorboat, sailboat, or motorized pontoon at least 16 feet in length but less than 19 feet in  
7 length, \$125.50; and

8           ~~(c)(iii)~~ for a motorboat, sailboat, or motorized pontoon 19 feet in length or longer, \$295.50.

9           **(b)** For a motorboat, sailboat, personal watercraft, or motorized pontoon with a manufacturer's  
10 suggested retail price of more than \$150,000 that is 10 years old or less, the one-time registration fee is the  
11 amount provided in subsection (10)(a) plus 1% of the manufacturer's suggested retail price.

12           (11) (a) Except as provided in subsections (11)(b), (11)(c), and (15), the one-time registration fee for  
13 a snowmobile is \$60.50.

14           (b) Whenever a valid winter trail pass issued pursuant to 23-2-636 is affixed to a snowmobile, the  
15 one-time registration fee is \$40.50.

16           (c) (i) A snowmobile that is licensed by a Montana business and is owned exclusively for the  
17 purpose of daily rental to customers is assessed:

18           (A) a fee of \$40.50 in the first year of registration; and

19           (B) if the business reregisters the snowmobile for a second year, a fee of \$20.

20           (ii) If the business reregisters the snowmobile for a third year, the snowmobile must be  
21 permanently registered and the business is assessed the registration fee imposed in subsection (11)(a).

22           (12) (a) The one-time registration fee for a low-speed electric vehicle is \$25.

23           (b) The one-time registration fee for a golf cart that is owned by a person who has or is applying for  
24 a low-speed restricted driver's license is \$25.

25           (c) The one-time registration fee for golf carts authorized to operate on certain public streets and  
26 highways pursuant to 61-8-391 is \$25. Upon receipt of the fee, the department shall issue the owner a decal,  
27 which must be displayed visibly on the golf cart.

28           (13) (a) Except as provided in subsection (13)(b), a fee of \$10 must be collected when a new set of

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1 standard license plates, a new single standard license plate, or a replacement set of special license plates  
2 required under 61-3-332 is issued. The \$10 fee imposed under this subsection does not apply when previously  
3 issued license plates are transferred under 61-3-335. All registration fees imposed under this section must be  
4 paid if the vehicle to which the plates are transferred is not currently registered.

5 (b) An additional fee of \$15 must be collected if a vehicle owner elects to keep the same license  
6 plate number from license plates issued before January 1, 2010, when replacement of those plates is required  
7 under 61-3-332(3).

8 (c) The fees imposed in this subsection (13) must be deposited in the account established under  
9 61-6-158, except that \$2 of the fee imposed in subsection (13)(a) must be deposited in the state general fund.

10 (14) The provisions of this part with respect to the payment of registration fees do not apply to and  
11 are not binding upon motor vehicles, trailers, semitrailers, snowmobiles, watercraft, or tractors owned or  
12 controlled by the United States of America or any state, county, city, or special district, as defined in 18-8-202,  
13 or to a vehicle or vessel that meets the description of property exempt from taxation under 15-6-201(1)(a),  
14 (1)(d), (1)(e), (1)(g), (1)(h), (1)(i), (1)(k), (1)(l), (1)(n), or (1)(o), 15-6-203, or 15-6-215, except as provided in 61-  
15 3-520.

16 (15) Whenever ownership of a trailer, semitrailer, pole trailer, off-highway vehicle, motorcycle,  
17 quadricycle, travel trailer, motor home, motorboat, sailboat, personal watercraft, motorized pontoon,  
18 snowmobile, motor vehicle owned and operated solely as a collector's item pursuant to 61-3-411, or low-speed  
19 electric vehicle is transferred, the new owner shall title and register the vehicle or vessel as required by this  
20 chapter and pay the fees imposed under this section.

21 (16) A person eligible for a waiver under 61-3-460 is exempt from the fees required under this  
22 section.

23 (17) Except as otherwise provided in this section, revenue collected under this section must be  
24 deposited in the state general fund.

25 (18) The fees imposed by subsections (2) through (12) are not required to be paid by a dealer for  
26 the enumerated vehicles or vessels that constitute inventory of the dealership.

27 (19) (a) Unless a person exercises the option in either subsection (19)(b) or (19)(c), an additional  
28 fee of \$9 must be collected for each light vehicle registered under this part. This fee must be accounted for and

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1 transmitted separately from the registration fee. Of the \$9 fee:

2 (i) \$6.74 must be deposited in the state special revenue account established in 23-1-105 and  
3 used for state parks;

4 (ii) 50 cents must be deposited in an account in the state special revenue fund to the credit of the  
5 department of fish, wildlife, and parks and used for fishing access sites;

6 (iii) \$1.37 must be deposited in the trails and recreation facilities state special revenue account  
7 established in 23-2-108; and

8 (iv) 39 cents must be deposited in the Montana heritage preservation and development account  
9 established in 22-3-1004 and used for the operation of state-owned facilities at Virginia City and Nevada City.

10 (b) A person who registers a light vehicle may, at the time of annual registration, certify that the  
11 person does not intend to use the vehicle to visit state parks and fishing access sites and may make a written  
12 election not to pay the additional \$9 fee provided for in subsection (19)(a). If a written election is made, the fee  
13 may not be collected.

14 (c) (i) A person who registers one or more light vehicles may, at the time of annual registration,  
15 certify that the person does not intend to use any of the vehicles to visit state parks and fishing access sites and  
16 may make a written election not to pay the additional \$9 fee provided for in subsection (19)(a). If a written  
17 election is made, the fee may not be collected at any subsequent annual registration unless the person makes  
18 the written election to pay the additional fee on one or more of the light vehicles.

19 (ii) The written election not to pay the additional fee on a light vehicle expires if the vehicle is  
20 registered to a different person.

21 (20) For each light vehicle, trailer, semitrailer, pole trailer, heavy truck, motor home, motorcycle,  
22 quadricycle, and travel trailer subject to a registration fee under this section, an additional fee of \$10 must be  
23 collected and forwarded to the state for deposit in the account established in 44-1-504.

24 (21) (a) If a person exercises the option in subsection (21)(b), an additional fee of \$5 must be  
25 collected for each light vehicle registered under this part. This fee must be accounted for and transmitted  
26 separately from the registration fee. The fee must be deposited in an account in the state special revenue fund.  
27 Funds in the account are statutorily appropriated, as provided in 17-7-502, to the department of transportation  
28 and must be allocated as provided in 60-3-309.

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1 (b) A person who registers one or more light vehicles may, at the time of annual registration, make  
2 a written or electronic election to pay the additional \$5 fee provided for in subsection (21)(a).

3 (22) This section does not apply to a motor vehicle, trailer, semitrailer, or pole trailer that is  
4 governed by 61-3-721.

5 (23) (a) The ~~\$800 and \$825~~ amounts collected based on the manufacturer's suggested retail price  
6 in subsections (2)(b) and (7)(c) are exempt from the provisions of 15-1-122 and must be deposited in the motor  
7 vehicle division administration account established in 61-3-112.

8 (b) By August 15 of each year, beginning in the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019, the department  
9 of justice shall deposit into the general fund an amount equal to the fiscal yearend balance minus 25% of the  
10 current fiscal year appropriation for the account established in 61-3-112.

11 (24) Beginning January 1, 2025, the ~~amounts manufacturer's suggested retail price~~ provided for in  
12 subsections (2)(b), (7)(c), and (10)(b) must be increased annually by 2%.

13 (25) For the purposes of this section, "manufacturer's suggested retail price" means the price  
14 suggested by a manufacturer for each given type, style, or model of a light vehicle, or motor home, motorboat,  
15 sailboat, personal watercraft, or motorized pontoon produced and first made available for retail sale by the  
16 manufacturer and adjusted based on the age of the vehicle using the schedule in 61-3-503 for a sport utility  
17 vehicle."
