9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11	Section 1. Section 10-2-108, MCA, is amended to read:		
12	"10-2-108. Veterans and surviving spouses state special revenue account. (1) There is a		
13	veterans and surviving spouses account in the state special revenue fund to be administered by the veterans'		
14	affairs division of the department of military affairs. The account consists of revenue deposited pursuant to 16-		
15	12-111 <u>and 16-11-119</u> .		
16	(2) The account must be used to provide services and assistance for all Montana veterans and		
17	surviving spouses and dependents."

19	Section 2. Section 16-11-119, MCA, is amended to read:		
20	"16-11-119. Disposition of taxes statutory appropriation. (1) A sum equal to the amount		
21	necessary to purchase cigarette tax stamps must be deposited to or allocated from the state special revenue		
22	fund to the credit of the department from cigarette taxes collected under the provisions of 16-11-111, as		
23	provided in subsection (5) of this section.		
24	(2) After the deposit or allocation in subsection (1), cigarette taxes collected under the provisions		
25	of 16-11-111 must, in accordance with the provisions of 17-2-124, be deposited as follows:		
26	(a) 8.3% or \$4 million, whichever is greater, in the state special revenue fund to the credit of the		
27	department of public health and human services for the operation and maintenance of state veterans' nursing

2	(b)	2.6% in the major repair long-range building program account provided for in 17-7-221;	
3	(c)	44% in the state special revenue fund to the credit of the health and medicaid initiatives	
4	account provided for in 53-6-1201; and		
5	(d)	\$150,000 in the veterans and surviving spouses state special revenue account provided for in	
6	<u>10-2-108;</u>		
7	<u>(e)</u>	_the remainder to the state general fund.	
8	(3)	If money in the state special revenue fund for the operation and maintenance of state veterans'	
9	nursing homes exceeds \$2 million at the end of the fiscal year, the excess must be transferred to the state		
10	general fund.		
11	(4)	The taxes collected on tobacco products other than cigarettes must in accordance with the	
12	provisions of 17-2-124 be deposited as follows:		
13	(a)	one-half in the state general fund; and	
14	(b)	one-half in the state special revenue fund account for health and medicaid initiatives provided	
15	for in 53-6-1201.		
16	(5)	Each fiscal year, a sum equal to the amount of money necessary to purchase cigarette tax	
17	stamps is statutorily appropriated, as provided in 17-7-502, from the state special revenue fund allocation in		
18	subsection (1) to the department for tax administration responsibilities."

20	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Transfer of funds. By August 15, 2023, the state treasurer shall transfer		
21	\$500 from the general fund to the primary sector business training account established in 39-11-205.

23	NEW SECTION. Section 4. Effective date. [This act] is effective July 1, 2023.
