12	Section	on 1. Section 87-5-301, MCA, is amended to read:
13	"87-5-301. Grizzly bear findings policy. (1) The legislature finds that:	
14	(a)	grizzly bears are a recovered population and thrive under responsive cooperative
15	. ,	grizziy bears are a recovered population and timive under responsive cooperative
16	management;	grizzly hear conservation is best conved under state management and the level, state, tribal
	(b)	grizzly bear conservation is best served under state management and the local, state, tribal,
17	and federal partnerships that fostered recovery; and	
18	(c)	successful conflict management is key to maintaining public support for conservation of the
19	grizzly bear.	
20	(2)	It is the policy of the state to:
21	(a)	manage the grizzly bear as a species in need of management to avoid minimize conflicts with
22	humans and livestock; and	
23	(b)	on delisting, manage grizzly bear populations at levels to maintain their delisted status to
24	include the management of mortalities from all sources, including hunting and the loss of grizzly bears by	
25	translocation out of the populations; and	
26	<u>(c)</u>	_subject to the provisions of subsection (3), use proactive management to control grizzly bear
27	distribution and prevent conflicts, including nonlethal and preventive measures as well as trapping and lethal	
28	measures.	



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(3) (a) Except as provided in subsection (3)(b), the department may not relocate a grizzly bear listed under the federal Endangered Species Act, 16 U.S.C. 1531, et seq., except to a release site previously approved by the commission for relocation of grizzly bears.

(b) The department may respond to a grizzly bear listed under the federal Endangered Species Act, 16 U.S.C. 1531, et seq., that is causing conflict outside of a federal recovery zone. If the bear is to be relocated, the department may not relocate the bear."

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NEW SECTION. Section 2. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.

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
