8	WHEREAS, a well-operating child protective services system relies on accurate and effective
9	information and communication; and
10	WHEREAS, child protective services situations are highly emotional and deserve a rapid and
11	professional response that can be facilitated by a comprehensive, up-to-date computer system; and
12	WHEREAS, the Department of Public Health and Human Services declared its intent to build a
13	comprehensive child welfare information system in 2018 but has delayed implementation of the system due to
14	other information technology needs.

16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
17	
18	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Direction to department of public health and human services. The
19	legislature directs the department of public health and human services to:
20	(a) complete its planned development of a comprehensive child welfare information system no
21	later than June 20,-2025_2027; and
22	(b) allocate the resources necessary to complete the system by that date.

24	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
