16	(b) enter into a contract with a foreign adversary that results in the foreign adversary's control of			
17	agricultural production land or critical infrastructure in this state. A FOREIGN ADVERSARY MAY NOT:			
18	(A) BUY, LEASE, OR RENT CRITICAL INFRASTRUCTURE OR, LAND USED FOR AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTION,			
19	OR REAL PROPERTY OR A RESIDENCE THAT HAS A DIRECT LINE OF SIGHT TO ANY PART OF A MILITARY INSTALLATION FROM			
20	AN ENTITY PROVIDED FOR IN THIS TITLE; OR
