13	person purposely or knowingly:		
14	(a) recruits, transports, transfers, harbors, receives, provides, obtains, isolates, maintains, or		
15	entices another person intending or knowing that the person will be subjected to involuntary servitude or sexual		
16	servitude; or		
17	(b) benefits, financially or by receiving anything of value, from facilitating any conduct described in		
18	subsection (1)(a) or from participation in a venture that has subjected another person to involuntary servitude		
19	sexual servitude.		
20	(2) (a) Except as provided in subsections (2)(b) and (2)(c), a person convicted of the offense of		
21	trafficking of persons shall be imprisoned in the state prison for a term of not more than 15 years, fined an		
22	amount not to exceed \$50,000 in the amount of \$400,000, or both.		
23	(b) A person convicted of the offense of trafficking of persons shall be imprisoned in the state
