8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Criminal trespass by unmanned aerial vehicle EXCEPTIONS. (1) A
11	EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (3), A person commits the offense of criminal trespass by unmanned aerial
12	vehicle if the person knowingly causes an unmanned aerial vehicle to fly 200 feet or lower over the property or
13	residence of another person without the authorization of the property owner or resident.
14	(2) A person convicted of the offense of criminal trespass by unmanned aerial vehicle shall be
15	fined \$500.
16	(3) SUBSECTION (1) DOES NOT APPLY TO THE OPERATION OF AN UNMANNED AERIAL VEHICLE SYSTEM:
17	(A) CONDUCTED BY A UNIT OR AGENCY OF THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT, THE STATE, OR A TRIBAL OR LOCAL
18	GOVERNMENT, INCLUDING ANY INDIVIDUAL CONDUCTING AN OPERATION PURSUANT TO A CONTRACT OR OTHER
19	AGREEMENT ENTERED INTO WITH THE UNIT OR AGENCY, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROTECTING THE PUBLIC SAFETY,
20	ENVIRONMENT, AND WELFARE, INCLUDING FIREFIGHTING, LAW ENFORCEMENT, OR EMERGENCY RESPONSE;
21	(B) BY A PEACE OFFICER ACTING IN ACCORDANCE WITH 46-5-109;
22	(C) WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF AN EASEMENT WITH THE PERMISSION OF THE OWNER OF THE DOMINANT
23	TENEMENT; OR
24	(D) BEING USED BY AN EMPLOYEE OR CONTRACTOR OF A property and casualty insurance carrier, a
25	common carrier pipeline as defined in 69-13-101, a railroad carrier as defined in 69-14-1203, a UTILITY AS
26	DEFINED IN 69-5-102 OR A PROVIDER OF BROADBAND SERVICE AS DEFINED IN 90-1-602 TO HELP ASSESS PROPERTY
27	DAMAGE OR CATASTROPHE DAMAGE OR TO INSPECT PROPERTY AND EQUIPMENT, INCLUDING CELL TOWERS AND

2	(e) by a business entity doing business lawfully in this state using an unmanned aerial vehicle for
3	legitimate business purposes, if that entity has landowner permission, established through a contractual
4	relationship or other documentary evidence.
5	(3)(4) "Unmanned aerial vehicle" has the meaning provided in 76-13-214.

7	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
8	integral part of Title 45, chapter 6, part 2, and the provisions of Title 45, chapter 6, part 2, apply to [section 1].
