19	website the fol	lowing information regarding contracts for services that would require a person to register as a	
20	lobbyist under	Title 5, chapter 7:	
21	(a)	the contract execution date;	
22	(b)	the duration of the contract, including any extension options;	
23	(c)	the effective date;	
24	(d)	the total amount of money the local government paid in the previous fiscal year;	
25	(e)	the identity of all parties to the contract;	
26	(f)	the identity of any subcontractor to the contract; and	
27	(g)	a list of all legislation advocated for or against by all parties and subcontractors to the contract,	
28	including the position taken on each piece of legislation in the prior fiscal year.

2	government ma	ay post the contract for lobbying services on the local government's website as long as the

5	within 60 days	after the end of the fiscal year in which the contract is signed. The information must remain
6	posted to the w	ebsite until the information is required to be updated under this section.

8	notice that cont	ract for lobbying services is available for review by the public at the office of the local
