18	(b) (i) The term includes a serious adverse event experienced by an employee after receiving a		
19	vaccine mandated by an employer.		
20	(ii) For the purposes of subsection (1)(b), "serious adverse event" means:		
21	(A) death or a life-threatening illness;		
22	(B) hospitalization or the prolongation of an existing hospitalization;		
23	(C) a persistent or significant incapacity or substantial disruption of the ability to conduct normal life
