FISCAL ANALYSIS

Assumptions:

Commissioner of Political Practices (COPP)

- 1. COPP assumes that any investigation or determination into a candidate's voter registration status would need to be conducted for all candidates elected to public office.
- 2. For candidates for election to a statewide or state district office, COPP assumes that such an investigation or determination into a candidate's voter registration status would be conducted by Montana's Secretary of State's office, not COPP.
- 3. For candidates for election to local office, COPP assumes that such an investigation or determination into a candidate's voter registration status would be conducted by the relevant election administrator, not COPP.
- 4. COPP assumes that any assistance its staff provides to Montana's Secretary of State's office or a relevant election administrator in conducting an investigation or determination into a candidate's voter registration status would be minimal, and handled as part of that staff's regular duties.

5. The Office of the Secretary of State will not have a fiscal impact associated with implementing this bill.
