<u>Description of fiscal impact:</u> The enforcement of HB 349 would be the responsibility of the Attorney General - Office of Consumer Protection, through civil actions. The Division of Criminal Investigation (DCI) will require an additional investigator, attorney, and paralegal to accomplish proper investigation and litigation of complaints.

### FISCAL ANALYSIS

#### **Assumptions:**

#### **Department of Justice**

- 1. HB 349 allows for a private right of action if the attorney general fails to respond within 45 days or responds within 45 days the complaint lacks merit.
- 2. The DoJ expects an increase in current investigations of consumer complaints by 15%, or approximately 150 additional investigations per year.
- 3. DCI assumes the salary and benefits for 1.00 FTE paralegal at \$71,650, 1.00 FTE attorney at \$120,818, and 1.00 FTE investigator at \$90,825 per year.
- 4. An undercover vehicle will be necessary for travel needs required for investigations as a one-time-only purchase of \$35,000.
- 5. It is estimated that one case per year would go to litigation with a cell phone manufacturer and need outside counsel/expert witnesses at a cost of \$250,000.

- 6. It is estimated that that there will be annual operating costs of \$41,503, and a one-time cost of \$9,156 in the first year for set-up of the office for 3.00 new FTE.
- 7. A 1.5% inflation rate has been applied in the FY 2026 and FY 2027.
