<u>Description of fiscal impact:</u> HB 79 creates a sexual assault response network program within the Department of Justice. This would increase expenditures at the Division of Criminal Investigation (DCI).

- 1. The Division of Criminal Investigation (DCI) assumes that this legislation would require 1.00 FTE program manager to coordinate a statewide sexual assault response network program to improve access to standardized care for survivors of sexual assault. DCI assumes a total annual cost for this position of \$110,984 for salary and fringe benefits. FY 2024 also includes \$3,000 in operating for startup costs.
- 2. DCI assumes that the employee will have in-state travel to implement sexual assault response trainings and coordinate with stakeholders and the committee established in the bill to develop best practices and procedures. In-state travel will include travel to conduct education, outreach with stakeholders, and provide

technical assistance. Out of state travel will be necessary to attend professional conference and/or to shadow practices in other states. DCI assumes the total annual cost of this travel will be \$10,000.

- 3. DCI estimates operating costs including training and conference setup to be \$17,381 annually.
- 4. The Forensic Science Division (FSD) assumes that minor additional travel costs would be incurred for Helena meeting attendance. FSD assumes this annual cost would be \$154.
- 5. A 1.5% per year inflation factor has been applied for FY 2026 and FY 2027.
