**Description of fiscal impact:** This bill allows county commissioners to request a random-sample audit of votecounting machines after a non-federal election. County commissioners can also request the addition of a countywide race to the random-sample audit of vote-counting machines after a federal election. Although there may be a minimal cost to the state for training and administrative rule making related to this legislation, these expenses can be absorbed by the Office of the Secretary of State.

#### **Assumptions:**

#### Office of the Secretary of State

1. While there may be a minimal fiscal impact related to training and administrative rulemaking related to this legislation, the Office of the Secretary of State can absorb these costs within the office's existing operating budget.

# Effect on County or Other Local Revenues or Expenditures:

#### **Montana Association of Counties**

1. The fiscal impact from HB 172 is not quantifiable based on the variability in county election costs. This bill allows for a county recount at the discretion of the Board of County Commissioners, so the cost will be evaluated by the board as needed.
