<u>Description of fiscal impact:</u> HB 492 removes the fee described in 69-3-844, MCA, which is already excluded from charges to sales price regarding the retail telecommunications excise tax in 15-53-129, MCA. The bill eliminates little used provisions of Telecommunications Act related to the state universal service fund and rate regulation of (small) telecommunications carriers.
