<u>Description of fiscal impact:</u> With the passage of HB 519, the Department of Justice (DoJ) would see a one-time cost in the first year and a minor decrease in annual revenue.

FISCAL ANALYSIS

Assumptions:

Department of Justice – Motor Vehicle Division (MVD)

- 1. It is assumed that the Motor Vehicle Division (MVD) will initially need the Credentialing and Registration System (CARS) programmed to issue digital driver's licenses. The estimated quote received from the vendor is \$700,000.
- 2. It is assumed that the Montana Highway Patrol would see a slight decrease in revenue due to issuing fewer driving without a license citations. It is estimated that approximately 22 citations are written each year and that each fee is \$60, therefore it is estimated that the loss in revenue would be \$1,320. (22 X 60 = \$1,320)
- 3. 50% of revenue received from citations is deposited into the state general fund and 50% goes to the county in which the citation was written.

Effect on County or Other Local Revenues or Expenditures:

1. Half of fine revenue goes to the county in which the citation was written. As a result, the local governments would potentially see a decrease of \$660 in revenue.
