<u>Description of fiscal impact:</u> This proposed legislation revises eligibility criteria for absentee ballots and requires applications for absentee ballots be submitted in January of every even-numbered year. This bill has no fiscal impact to the Office of the Secretary of State. However, there will be a fiscal impact to local governments to mail absentee ballot renewal cards every other year.

1. There is no fiscal impact to the Office of the Secretary of State associated with implementing the requirements of this since the proposed legislation does not require the office to assume any additional responsibilities.

Montana Association of Counties

1. The proposed legislation requires each county to send absentee ballot renewal cards every other year to individuals already on the absentee ballot list. The estimated costs for this mailing is \$569,433.
