
Assumptions

Department of Public Health and Human Services

1. This amendment requires DPPHHS to complete additional reporting, develop outcome measures and adds a quality control requirement.
2. DPHHS assumes that these requirements can be met if given the appropriation and technical assistance of the original fiscal note and contractor will absorb these additional items in amendment.
3. No additional fiscal impact.

Office of Public Instruction (OPI)

4. HB 822 requires parental or guardian consent and involvement with school-based behavior health services which will be a change for the schools.
5. OPI has determined that there will be no additional fiscal impact for this bill.
