<u>Description of fiscal impact:</u> This amended bill adds additional reporting, outcome measures and requires the Department of Public Health and Human Services (DPHHS) to implement a quality control program. Also, there is a requirement that DPHHS require parental or guardian consent and involvement with school-based behavior health services.

Assumptions

Department of Public Health and Human Services

- 1. This amendment requires DPPHHS to complete additional reporting, develop outcome measures and adds a quality control requirement.
- 2. DPHHS assumes that these requirements can be met if given the appropriation and technical assistance of the original fiscal note and contractor will absorb these additional items in amendment.
- 3. No additional fiscal impact.

Office of Public Instruction (OPI)

- 4. HB 822 requires parental or guardian consent and involvement with school-based behavior health services which will be a change for the schools.
- 5. OPI has determined that there will be no additional fiscal impact for this bill.
