Description of fiscal impact: SB 153 has no fiscal impact to the state.

FISCAL ANALYSIS

Assumptions:

- 1. During the 2021 Legislative Session, HB 651 amended 13-27-202, MCA, to require a person who employs a paid signature gatherer to register with the Secretary of State and provided the Secretary of State authority to establish a filing fee of no more than \$100 for the registration.
- 2. ARM 44.3.2801 established a \$0 filing fee for the required registration.
- 3. Since the passage of HB 651 (2021 Session), the Office of the Secretary of State has not received any registrations of persons employing a paid signature gatherer.
- 4. SB 153 proposes to remove the requirement for a paid signature gatherer to register with the Secretary of State. This change will have no fiscal impact.
