Assumptions:

1. SB 162 will require that foster parents, pre-adoptive parents, or relatives of a child placed in their care be provided a written notice explaining their rights to receive notice, to appear and be heard, and attempt to intervene in judicial proceedings. The notice will be developed and included with information provided to foster parents, pre-adoptive parents, or relatives upon placement of a child in their care. The cost to develop and provide the notice will not create a fiscal impact to the Department of Public Health and Human Services.
