<u>Description of fiscal impact:</u> SB 212 revises the education requirements for state jobs and directs the Department of Administration's State Human Resources Division to develop alternatives to advanced degree requirements in job descriptions based on experience and certification. The division will use existing staff and resources to comply with the requirements, so there is no fiscal impact to the state from this legislation.
