**Description of fiscal impact:** SB 373 revises laws relating to teacher certification adding an alternative teacher credentialing for a Class 2 standard certificate and modifies the qualifications to become a certified teacher. There is no fiscal impact related to the bill.

- The Office of Public Instruction (OPI) can absorb the costs associate with SB 373 which would include minor changes to the OPI licensure system which would be covered under OPI's current maintenance agreement for the licensure system.
