<u>Description of fiscal impact:</u> SB 509 repeals 37-61-211, MCA, which requires an attorney or counselor at law to pay a license tax of \$25.00 a year. The lack of this requirement will reduce costs to the Clerk of Court and reduce revenue to the general fund.

Assumptions:

Net Impact-General Fund Balance:

- 1. Currently the Clerk of Court pays the State Bar \$7,500 a year to facilitate the collection of the fees. With the repeal of the fees, this expense will no longer be paid.
- 2. Based on actual revenue collections between FY 2017 and FY 2022, annual fees collected average \$124,000. This bill would eliminate this general fund revenue funding source. It is assumed that the general fund will lose revenue in the amount of \$124,000 each fiscal year.
