9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11	Section 1. Section 20-5-103, MCA, is amended to read:	
12	"20-5-103.	Compulsory attendance and excuses. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), any
13	parent, guardian, o	r other person who is responsible for the care of any child who is 7 years of age or older
14	prior to the first day of school in any school fiscal year shall cause the child to attend the school in which the	
15	child is enrolled for the school term and each school day in the term prescribed by the trustees of the district	
16	until the later of the following dates:	
17	(a) the	e child's 16th birthday; or
18	(b) the	e date of completion of the work of the 8th grade.
19	(2) Th	e provisions of subsection (1) do not apply in the following cases:
20	(a) Th	e child has been excused under one of the conditions specified in 20-5-102.
21	(b) Th	e child is absent because of illness, mental health needs, bereavement, or other reason
22	prescribed by the policies of the trustees.	
23	(c) Th	e child has been suspended or expelled under the provisions of 20-5-202.
24	(d) Th	e child is excused pursuant to 20-7-120."
