6	A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT PROVIDING THAT A STUDENT MAY USE PHYSICAL FORCE II
7	SELF-DEFENSE OR IN DEFENSE OF ANOTHER IN RESPONSE TO BULLYING; AMENDING SECTION 20
8	5-209, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE."

10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
11	
12	Section 1. Section 20-5-209, MCA, is amended to read:
13	"20-5-209. Bullying of student prohibited self-defense authorized. (1) Bullying of a student
14	enrolled in a public K-12 school by another student or an employee is prohibited.
15	(2) A student who is subjected to or who witnesses another person being subjected to physical
16	bullying is entitled to use physical force in self-defense or in the defense of another person pursuant to 45-3-
17	<u>102.</u>
18	(3) A school district shall investigate a student's use of physical force and may not reprimand or
19	discipline a student who claims the student used physical force in self-defense or in defense of another if the
20	investigation:
21	(a) finds that the student was not the aggressor; or
22	(b) does not find proof contrary to the student's claim."
