16	(b) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (5), must have registered as a social worker licensure				
17	candidate, as provided in 37-22-313, and completed supervised work experience as specified in 37-22-313 and				
18	board rule. Some of the required hours must be in direct client contact.
