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10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
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12	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Information to be provided to prospective adoptive parents foster
13	care licensing. (1) A department or agency from which an individual is seeking to adopt a child shall provide
14	the individual seeking to adopt with information related to the requirements and process for becoming a
15	licensed foster parent in this state.
16	(2) A state-licensed child-placing agency shall display signage and literature regarding the
17	requirements and process for becoming a licensed foster parent. Signage must be placed on the premises in a
18	manner that is visible to the public.
19	(3) The department of public health and human services shall provide signage and literature to all
20	state-licensed child-placing agencies for the purposes described in this section.
