8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Certain vehicles to carry tire traction devices during winter months.
11	(1) (A) From EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (1)(B), FROM October 1 through April 30, a person operating a
12	tow truck, highway maintenance vehicle, motor truck of 1-ton capacity 26,000 26,001 GVW or greater,
13	passenger bus, or truck tractor TOWING A TRAILER on a mountain pass or on a similar stretch of highway
14	designated by the department of transportation as a place where traction control devices may be ARE
15	POTENTIALLY required shall carry in the vehicle <u>APPROVED</u> traction control devices prescribed by the department.
16	(B) THE REQUIREMENT OF SUBSECTION (1)(A) DOES NOT APPLY TO A VEHICLE WITH FOUR-WHEEL DRIVE.
17	(2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE PUNISHED BY A FINE OF \$225
18	FOR A FIRST OFFENSE AND NOT LESS THAN \$225 OR MORE THAN \$500 FOR SUBSEQUENT OFFENSES.
19	(2)(3) The department may adopt administrative rules to implement this section.

21	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
22	integral part of Title 61, chapter 9, part 4, and the provisions of Title 61, chapter 9, part 4, apply to [section 1].
