 5 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REVISING LAWS RELATED TO HEALTH EDUCATION;
 6 REQUIRING SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO INCLUDE MATERIALS ON EARLY FETAL DEVELOPMENT; AND
 7 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE."

 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

 11 NEW SECTION. **Section 1. Requirements for high school instruction related to human**
 12 **reproduction.** When providing instruction on human reproduction to high school students to meet health
 13 content standards adopted by the board of public education, a school district shall include the following:

- 14 (1) a high-definition ultrasound video, at least 3 minutes in duration, showing the development of
- 15 the brain, heart, sex organs, and other vital organs in early fetal development; and
- 16 (2) a high-quality, computer-generated rendering or animation showing the process of fertilization
- 17 and every stage of human development inside the uterus, noting significant markers in cell growth and organ
- 18 development for every week of pregnancy until birth.

 20 NEW SECTION. **Section 2. Codification instruction.** [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
 21 integral part of Title 20, chapter 7, part 1, and the provisions of Title 20, chapter 7, part 1, apply to [section 1].

 23 NEW SECTION. **Section 3. Effective date.** [This act] is effective July 1, 2023.
