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8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
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10	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Exemption for providing employee housing. (1) There is an
11	exemption for property wholly owned by an employer that is used as a dwelling by an employee. To be eligible
12	for the exemption, applicants must meet the requirements of this section.
13	(2) The exemption provided for in this section is equal to 20% of the appraised value of the
14	dwelling.
15	(3) A dwelling used by an employee and the employee's family is eligible for the exemption if the
16	dwelling is rented to the employee or provided to the employee as part of the employee's compensation.
17	(4) To claim the exemption provided for in this section, the employer shall file an application with
18	the department of revenue by March 1 of the tax year in which the exemption is sought. The application must
19	contain an affirmation that the dwelling is used by an employee and any other information required by the
20	department.
21	(5) As used in this section, "dwelling" means a residential dwelling, manufactured home, trailer,
22	mobile home, or multiple-unit dwelling that is subject to property taxes in the state and as much of the
23	surrounding land, but not in excess of 1 acre, as is reasonably necessary for its use as a dwelling.
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25	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
26	integral part of Title 15, chapter 6, part 2, and the provisions of Title 15, chapter 6, part 2, apply to [section 1].
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28	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Applicability. [This act] applies to property tax years beginning after

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1 December 31, 2023.

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
