To Whom it May Concern:

In accordance with M.C.A. § 5-2- 402, this letter serves as your official notification that a vacancy exists in House District 29 following the resignation of Representative Doug Flament. Pursuant to M.C.A. § 2-16-502 and as stipulated in his letter of resignation, former Representative Flament's resignation became effective on January 10, 2023. His resignation was filed in this office on January 10, 2023.

Please review Title 5, Chapter 2, Part 4 of the Montana Code Annotated concerning the procedure for filling legislative vacancies.

As soon as possible, please notify the Fergus and Petroleum Counties Republican Central Committees of the vacancy and direct the Committees to provide, within five (5) days of the Committees' receipt of your notification, the Fergus and Petroleum County Board of County Commissioners with a list of three prospective appointees to fill the legislative vacancy. Within five (5) days after receiving the list of prospective appointees, the Fergus and Petroleum Boards of County Commissioners must make and confirm an appoint and notify the Secretary of State.
