4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT EXEMPTING BARBERING SERVICES PROVIDED AT STATE
5 CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES AND COUNTY DETENTION CENTERS FROM LICENSING REQUIREMENTS;
6 AMENDING SECTION 37-31-102, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 **Section 1.** Section 37-31-102, MCA, is amended to read:

11 **"37-31-102. Exemptions.** The provisions of this chapter do not prohibit:

12 (1) service in case of emergency or domestic administration without compensation;

13 (2) services by persons authorized under the laws of this state to practice dentistry, the healing
14 arts, or mortuary science; ~~or~~

15 (3) barbering, cosmetology, or esthetics services, including the application of masks, makeup, or
16 other theatrical devices, in the course of or incidental to a theatrical or other visual arts production, including
17 television or motion pictures, by persons employed or under contract to provide these services; or

18 (4) barbering services performed at a correctional facility listed in 53-30-101 that is operated by or
19 under contract with the department of corrections or a detention center as defined in 7-32-2241."

21 NEW SECTION. **Section 2. Effective date.** [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
