12	Section 1. Section 3-1-902, MCA, is amended to read:
13	"3-1-902. Investigation qualifications for appointment. (1) The governor may authorize
14	investigations concerning the qualifications of eligible persons.
15	(2) (a) A-Except as provided in subsection (2)(b), a lawyer in good standing who has the
16	qualifications set forth by law for holding judicial office may be a candidate and may apply to the governor for
17	consideration, or application may be made by any person on the lawyer's behalf.
18	(b) An otherwise qualified lawyer may not apply or be a candidate for holding a judicial office under
19	this part if the lawyer has lost an election for a judicial office in the state at any time."
