There's nothing pretty about her but somehow she's strong and free, and big and rugged and well, comrade, she looks pretty good to me. She's beautiful too in her fashion and wonderful, strange old way with her chimneys and throbbing engines, her hillsides marred and gray. She's a goddess of wealth and power, it's a thing my words won't reach, it takes a man to express it that's born with a gift of speech. But some clear Autumn morning when the air is like a sip from a spring of sparkling water that touches a pilgrim's lip, Go out and look around you at the mountains against the sky Those quiet immutable mountains that carry their heads so high. And you feel that thrill of wonder that has no stain of pride that you are one of the mountains, the heart of the great divide.
