10 A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF
11 MONTANA COMMEMORATING ST. PATRICK'S DAY, CELEBRATING THE CONTRIBUTIONS OF
12 MONTANANS OF IRISH HERITAGE, AND EXPRESSING THE HOPE THAT THE CALM AND
13 COOPERATION THAT THE 1998 GOOD FRIDAY AGREEMENT HAS ENGENDERED IN IRELAND WILL
14 ENDURE.

16 WHEREAS, Irish immigrants contributed significantly to the formation of the cultural and societal
17 foundation of our nation; and

18 WHEREAS, 14 percent of Montanans are of Irish heritage, the highest percentage west of the
19 Mississippi River and the 9th highest percentage nationally, and Irish Montanans have risen to leadership roles
20 in many fields of endeavor; and

21 WHEREAS, Irish Americans remain proudly supportive of their ancestral homeland, and desire that
22 Ireland be economically prosperous and at peace, and

23 WHEREAS, the lyrics and music of the songs of Ireland convey the tragedy and joy and the sorrows
24 and glories of the Emerald Isle, and

25 WHEREAS, the American Irish State Legislators Caucus was recently established to foster and
26 strengthen the longstanding cordial bilateral relationship between the United States and Ireland, for the
27 continuing mutual benefit of both nations, and

28 WHEREAS, the 1998 Good Friday Agreement ushered in a new era of peace on the island of Ireland,

1 and the calm and cooperation the agreement has engendered are of the utmost importance for future peaceful
2 coexistence on the Emerald Isle, and

3 WHEREAS, annually, on St. Patrick's Day, Americans, regardless of their ancestral heritage, become
4 Irish for the day and jointly celebrate their love of Ireland.

6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
7 THE STATE OF MONTANA:

8 That the Montana Legislature commemorates St. Patrick's Day, celebrates the contributions of
9 Montanans of Irish heritage, and expresses the hope that the calm and cooperation that the 1998 Good Friday
10 Agreement has engendered in Ireland will endure.

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Montana Legislature desires to continue building the economic
12 relationship between Montana and Ireland.

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of State send a copy of this resolution to the National
14 Co-Chairs of the American Irish State Legislators Caucus, to Senator Mark Daly, the Cathaoirleach of Seanad
15 Éireann (Chair of the Senate of Ireland), and to Deputy Seán Ó Fearghail, the Ceann Comhairle of Dáil Éireann
16 (Chair of the Assembly of Ireland).
