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8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
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10	Section 1. Section 2, Chapter 364, Laws of 2017, is amended to read:
11	"Section 2. Montana developmental center requirements. (1) The appropriation to the department
12	of public health and human services in House Bill No. 2, under "Montana Developmental Center" is restricted to
13	the following:
14	(a) the following amounts must be transferred from the appropriation to the fire suppression account
15	provided for in 76-13-150:
16	(i) \$3.5 million in general fund money designated for personal services expenses in fiscal year 2018; and
17	(ii) \$4 million in general fund money designated for personal services expenses in fiscal year 2019; and
18	(b) the remainder may be used for:
19	(a)(i) expenditures at the Montana developmental center; or
20	(b)(ii) transfers pursuant to subsection (2).
21	(2) The department may transfer from "Montana Developmental Center" for other necessary services
22	for individuals served or who would have otherwise been served at the Montana Developmental Center.
23	(3) If the department transfers funding or full-time equivalents as allowed under subsection (1)(b)(ii) from
24	the appropriation under "Montana Developmental Center", the department must notify the legislative finance
25	committee and the legislative fiscal analyst.
26	(4) Any information that is confidential or personally identifiable provided pursuant to this section may only
27	be communicated to the legislative fiscal analyst, who will not release the information pursuant to 5-12-303."
