Background Materials and Research

Topic Summary: <u>Article IV, Part IV, section 2, of the Montana Constitution</u> provides the qualifications for electors in Montana: "**Section 2. Qualified elector.** Any citizen of the United States 18 years of age or older who meets the registration and residence requirements provided by law is a qualified elector unless he is serving a sentence for a felony in a penal institution or is of unsound mind, as determined by a court." The constitution also allows the legislature to provide for registration and residence requirements in law. Statute defines "elector" as "an individual qualified to vote under state law." Laws related to registration of electors are contained in <u>Title 13, chapter 2, MCA</u>.

Section 13-1-111, MCA, provides the qualifications for a voter, including that the voter must be:

- Registered to vote;
- 18 years of age or older;
- A resident of Montana and of the county in which the person intends to vote for at least 30 days (unless the voter has moved during the 30 days before an election, in which case the individual can vote in the previous county or update the elector's registration in accordance with the law.); and
- Be a citizen of the United States.

A person may not vote while being held in a penal institution. There is also a prohibition against a person voting if the person has been judged to be of an unsound mind, unless the person's rights have been restored.
