Background Materials and Research

Topic Summary: The rise in the costs of health care services has been of consistent concern to the Legislature in recent years, as lawmakers look for ways to reduce the costs to Montanans who are buying insurance and paying for health care services and for ways to reduce the impact of increasing costs on publicly funded programs. The following studies have been conducted in the past dozen years:

- House Joint Resolution 20, which studied health care price transparency in the 2017-2018 interim;
- House Joint Resolution 33, which looked at the implications, options and repercussions of a health insurance exchange in Montana during the 2011-2012 interim; and
- Senate Joint Resolution 35, which took a broad look at health care topics that ranged from the uninsured population to the state's health care workforce, medical malpractice laws, the use of health information technology and federal health care reform in the 2009-2010 interim.

Even earlier, studies looked at the health care delivery system (SJR 15 in 2007-2008); health insurance reform and publicly funded health care programs (HJR 48 in 2007-2008); and health care costs (SJR 22 in 2001-2002).
