VACCINE INFORMATION SHARING

Background Materials and Research

Topic Summary: The question of sharing information regarding a person's vaccination status has generated legislation to both easily allow sharing of the information and to prohibit its disclosure. Recent efforts have focused on ensuring that people don't have to share their vaccination status or certain immunization information. Other efforts have focused on an eletronic database of immunization records known as "imMTrax."

The imMTrax database provides a centralized repository for healthcare providers to share immunization records so each patient can receive desired vaccinations on the recommended schedule and avoid duplicate vaccinations because of incomplete or inaccessible records. Currently, imMTrax is an "opt-in" system, meaning patients must agree to have their immunization information included in the database. In recent legislative sessions, bills have been introduced to change to an "opt-out" system, where patients would automatically be enrolled in the database unless they specifically asked not to be included. The bills have also addressed limitations on disclosure of the database information.
