Background Materials and Research

Topic Summary: According to the state Department of Agriculture, about 8.2 million acres of land in Montana are affected be noxious weeds. There are 35 types of weeds documented in Montana. Weed infestations reduce the productivity of land used for crops or livestock. Weeds also deteriorate wildlife habitat and can choke out native plant species. State agencies, counties, and private landowners all play roles in the management of noxious weeds.
