Background Materials and Research

Topic Summary: <u>Title 7, Chapter 11, Part 10 MCA</u> authorizes county governing bodies to create special districts through resolution or referendum. As defined in <u>7-11-1002 MCA</u>, a special district is a unit of local government authorized by law to perform a single function or a limited number of functions, such as cemetery districts, museum districts, park districts, fair districts, solid waste districts, local improvement districts, mosquito control districts, multijurisdictional districts, road districts, rodent control districts, television districts, or any other district not specifically prohibited by law.

The local governing body or a separate elected or appointed board governs special districts and may procure funding through grants, donations, capital improvement funds, fees, and/or bonds. The governing body may alter boundaries, with restrictions noted in 7-11-1023 MCA, delete sections of a special district, or dissolve a special district through resolution. Voters can protest the creation, alteration, or dissolution of a special district.

While most of the common special districts utilized by local governments are found in Title 7, Chapter 11, Part 10 MCA, other types of special districts exist and maintain individual statutory guidance.
