# **COAL SEVERANCE TAX TRUST**

### **LEGISLATOR NOTICE**

The Legislative Services Division is required to offer a brief history on the subject matter of a bill draft request prior to drafting (5-4-105, MCA; Chapter 309, Laws of 2017). ## Background Materials and Research

Topic Summary: The Montana Constitution, Art. IX, sec. 5, establishes the coal trust. This provision requires that 50% of the coal severance tax received by the state each year be deposited into this trust fund. Although the interest and income from the trust may be appropriated, the principal of the trust may not be appropriated unless it is approved by a vote of three-fourths of the members of each house of the legislature.

The trust is divided into the following subtrusts:

- Coal Tax Bond Fund
- Permanent Fund
- Treasure State Endowment Fund
- Treasure State Endowment Regional Water System Fund
- Big Sky Economic Development Fund
- School Facilities Fund

Interest from these subtrusts is transferred into corresponding state special revenue accounts that are appropriated by the Legislature each session. <u>17-5-703</u>, MCA, currently provides that 75% of the coal severance tax deposited into the coal severance tax trust be deposited into the School Facilities Fund and the remaining 25% be deposited into the Big Sky Economic Development Fund.
