BICYCLES

Background Materials and Research

Topic Summary: MCA 61-8-102 defines a bicycle as "a vehicle propelled solely by human power on which any person may ride, irrespective of the number of wheels, except scooters, wheelchairs, and similar devices. The term includes an electrically assisted bicycle." MCA 61-8-320 governs the right-of-way for bicycles. MCA 61-8-601 et seq. governs bicycle use in general, including provisions regarding permissible and impermissible use of bicycles, use on roadways, use on sidewalks, use in bike lanes, and illumination and reflection equipment necessary for use during twilight and nighttime.

Legislators have introduced bills in past sessions seeking to specify distances that passing motor vehicles must maintain from bicycles. Legislators have also introduced bills seeking to modify the definition, use, and equipment of bicycles.
