Senate Bill 308 -- A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT CREATING THE OFFENSE OF REFUSAL TO SUBMIT TO A BLOOD OR BREATH TEST FOR THE PURPOSE OF DETERMINING ANY MEASURED AMOUNT OR DETECTED PRESENCE OF ALCOHOL OR DRUGS IN THE PERSON'S BODY WHEN REQUESTED BY A PEACE OFFICER; PROVIDING PENALTIES; AND AMENDING SECTION 61-8-402, MCA."

House Bill 18 -- A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT ADDING VEHICULAR HOMICIDE WHILE UNDER THE INFLUENCE AS A CRIME FOR WHICH A YOUTH 16 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER MAY BE CHARGED AS AN ADULT IN DISTRICT COURT; AND AMENDING SECTION 41-5-206, MCA."



House Bill 194 -- A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT STATUTORILY IMPOSING ACCOUNTABILITY FOR THE OFFENSES OF VEHICULAR HOMICIDE UNDER THE INFLUENCE AND NEGLIGENT VEHICULAR ASSAULT ON A PASSENGER OF THE VEHICLE UNLESS THE PASSENGER MAKES A TIMELY REPORT OF THE OFFENSE; REQUIRING THE PASSENGER TO REPORT THE OFFENSE TO LAW ENFORCEMENT AND TO THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE; AND AMENDING SECTIONS 45-2-302, 45-5-106, 45-5-205, AND 61-7-109, MCA."

House Bill 533 -- AN ACT ADDING VEHICULAR HOMICIDE WHILE UNDER THE INFLUENCE AS A CRIME FOR WHICH A YOUTH 16 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER MAY BE CHARGED AS AN ADULT IN DISTRICT COURT; AND AMENDING SECTION 41-5-206, MCA.
