TEXTING AND DRIVING

Background Materials and Research

Topic Summary: Legislators have introduced bills limiting or prohibiting texting while driving in general during recent sessions. In 2017, the House Transportation Committee considered a bill that would limit texting while driving in work zones and school zones. Legislators have also proposed bills limiting or prohibiting local authorities from passing ordinances restricting texting while driving.
